To ensure health and wellbeing, shoppers and donors are no longer allowed inside the Pantry building. Instead, an assortment of pre-bagged canned foods, proteins, and paper goods (based on the size of family), is being dispersed.

The BAFP is open from 4-6 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays and will maintain those hours until further notice.






