The Brandon Community Pool is open for the season

Daily open swim is from 1-4:30 p.m. and 6:30-8:50 p.m. Family swim time is 5-6:20 p.m. Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays.

Lap swim is from 5-5:45 p.m. Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

And water aerobics is 5:45-6:30 p.m. Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Before you go, keep the following in mind:

- Notifications for weather delays, closures, swimming lessons cancellations are made via the city's text notification system.

- Memberships are available for purchase online. No nannies or grandparents are included on family memberships; they must have their own.

- Membership key tags must be brought to the pool. Users who do not have the key tag, will be required to pay the daily fee or not enter the pool. Pool cashiers will not search membership names.

- Inflatable devices, including inflatable swimsuits, are not allowed.

- Food and drink are allowed in the pool area except for alcohol, glass or breakable products.

Automotive Advice from The Under the Hood® Show

Dear Motor Medics,

I have been looking at trucks to be used as both primary transportation and for pulling a camper in the summer. I have a half ton gas powered truck now that is used for about 20,000 miles per year but after upgrading my camper to a larger size this past summer, I don't feel it is safe to use as a pull truck any longer. I am a Ford guy and want to go with a diesel truck in a 3/4 or 1-ton model 4x4 but hear that most of the trucks in my price range are equipped with a 6.0 engine and that they have some inherent problems. What kind of things go wrong with the engine and what can be done to fix them? I may be willing to buy one and make the repairs

Thanks, Doug in Kalamazoo Michigan

Dear Doug,

It is smart of you to think safely. You should never pull with a truck that is too small for the job or safety will be compromised. The issues we see with the 6.0 are usually the egr cooler and the engine oil cooler. There are some strong aftermarket parts available to update the engine and once done we have seen greatly improved strength and little repeat failures so far. There are some great deals to be had on the 6.0 and if you find one budget for the upgrades to help prevent major future breakdowns.

Dear Motor Medics,

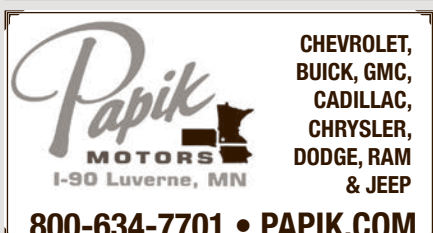
My car is dying. I have been told that it is unsafe to drive due to rust but on the outside, it looks fine. I have a 2005 Grand Prix, and they have shown me major rust in the rocker panel area that is covered up by the plastic ground effects. The rocker is actually gone but it doesn't seem to be supporting anything. I want to drive the car for a few more years, but they tell me the rust has severely compromised the structural integrity, and the main support structure is weakening so it will be very unsafe in a collision. Are there any repairs that I can make to help get it by for a couple of years until I'm ready for a new car?

Dear Martin,

We own one of these cars and I am in your exact situation now. The rockers were a concern a few years ago and I suspect yours were too. I'm afraid our few years have passed and with structural safety compromised the safest thing for us is to replace the car. Once rust has become this bad the cost of repairing it usually exceeds the economic value of the vehicle and replacement is a better choice. Daily driving may get us around but if a collision should occur our lives could be at risk, with rust there really is no temporary structural strengthening you can do to get by
