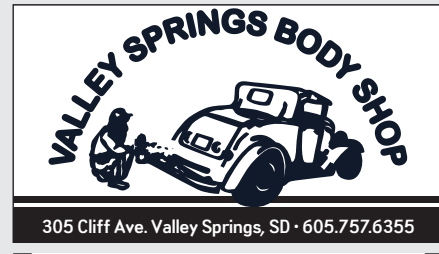
Automotive Advice from The Under the Hood® Show

Dear Motor Medics,  
 I first heard of your show while reading our local newspaper and started to listen to the podcasts on your website. While listening, I heard you mention that some vehicles have circuit board failures of the wiper motors and this will cause them to not operate when it is wet but they will operate when it is dry such as using your windshield washers. My vehicle is a 1998 Chevy 1/2 ton 4x4. Is this one of those vehicles and if so, how hard is it to repair?

Dear Fred,  
 Thanks for becoming a new listener. Your vehicle is one of the ones that can suffer from wiper failure when wet. The cause is moisture intrusion into the motor circuit board housing that can hinder proper operation. To repair the wipers the board needs to be replaced. You should check with a GM dealership because there may be some extended coverage to repair this item. To find out just call and give them your vehicle identification number and they can check for you. If there is no coverage you can do the job yourself with minimal tools and time. Make sure you verify that the board is the issue and not something else before you replace it. The board is a basic bolt on part. You may check with your local shop, the cost to repair the wiper board problem is usually very affordable to have done.

Dear Motor Medics,  
 I have owned a 1991 Dodge Caravan since it was new. We keep this van in great shape and live in Arizona where it does not see road salt or really cold winters and with 60,000 miles it still looks like brand new. We have had all of the maintenance done following the severe service intervals in the owner's manual and then some. Last week the brakes started to act up. While trying to stop, the pedal will get very hard to push down and you can't stop without both feet on the pedal. We had it checked at a local shop and they said the brake booster which also controls the antilock brakes was failing. They found one they could order and the cost was over \$1000.00 to replace it. We are considering the repair only because the van is so nice but the price seems steep. Is there anything else it could be?

Dear Mary,

We don't see many 1991 Dodge Caravans in great shape anymore. It's good to hear yours is still kicking. The brake booster is part of the abs and electric. When it fails it is expensive but on some of the vans there was an extended long term free repair due to the safety nature of the failure that was offered from the manufacturer. Check with them to see if you have coverage and if any parts are still available.

BAFP executive director Linda Weber asks groups that conduct food drives to contact the Pantry prior to dropping off donations. Used eye glasses and hearing aids for the Brandon Lions Club may also be dropped off at the BAFP.

**Current lawn watering restrictions**  
The city of Brandon is in stage 1 (green) of lawn watering restrictions. The even/odd schedules allow users

with even-numbered addresses to water on even-number calendar dates; users with odd-numbered address are allowed to water on odd-numbered calendar dates. Water restriction stages and other updates are posted on the city website and Facebook pages.

**City text notification systems available in Brandon, Valley Springs**  
To stay abreast of city-related notifications, both the cities of Brandon and Valley Springs have text messaging services available to residents. Brandon residents can sign up by texting "Brandon" to 33222 for notification of water conservation and snow alerts, water main breaks, street closures, etc. For pool notifications, text "Brandon-pool" to 33222. Residents in Valley Springs can stay abreast of emergencies, water shut downs, snow removal, etc. by texting "alerts" to (605) 250-3221.

**Valley Springs branch/leaf site open Tuesdays, Saturdays**  
Valley Springs residents can bring leaves, grass clippings and branches to the city brush site from 4-7 p.m. Tuesdays and 10 a.m.-1 p.m. Saturdays. The site is monitored and is available to city residents only. Proof of address is required. Users are asked to place leaves and grass in the designated area (no bags) and tree limbs and branches should be placed on the brush pile. No trash or concrete is allowed by dumped at the site.

**Brandon Senior Citizens**  
The Brandon Senior Citizens meet at 12:30 p.m. every Thursday at the VFW for Bingo, cards socializing and coffee. All seniors are welcome.

**Brandon Transit available to all**  
Brandon Transit is a public transportation service that is available to all. Services are provided from approximately 7:45 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Brandon Transit provides rides to medical and dental appointments, therapy, clinics, hospitals, nursing homes, assisted living centers, nutrition sites, governmental offices, day care, preschool, employment, shopping areas, and grocery stores. The fee is \$2 per ride or \$4 round trip. To schedule a ride, contact Brandon Transit at least one day in advance at 582-3553 between 7:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday.
