Trees located in the street right-of-way will be trimmed to a height of 10 feet over the sidewalk and 12 feet over the street.

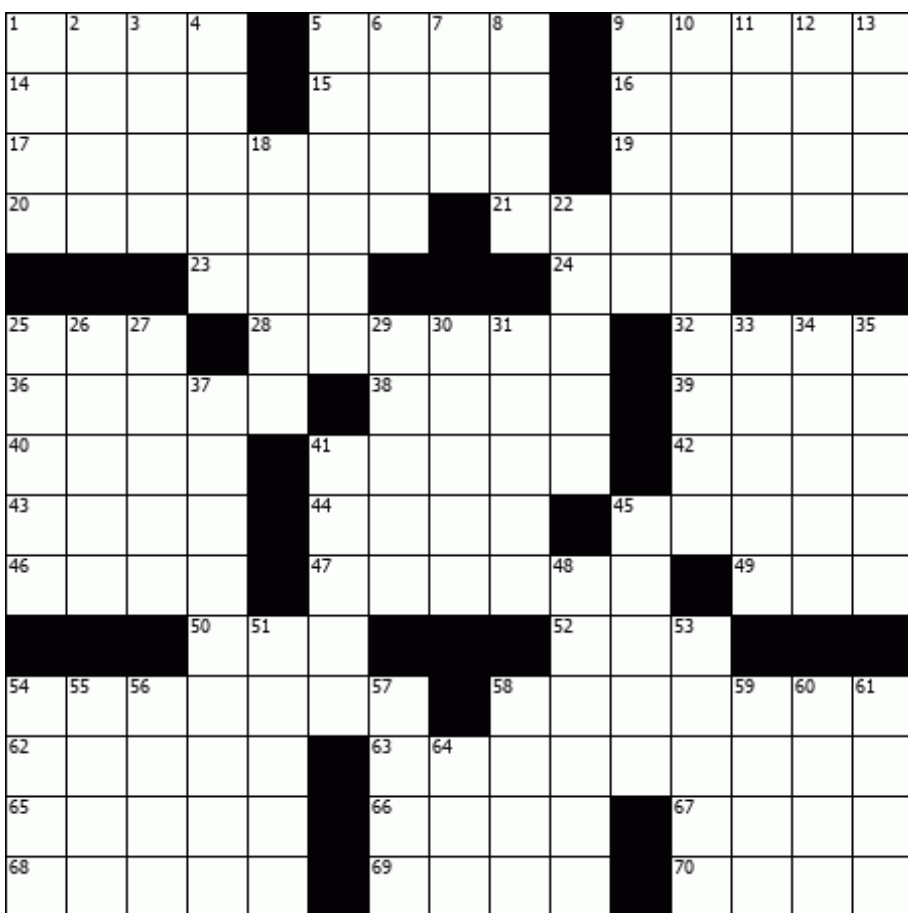

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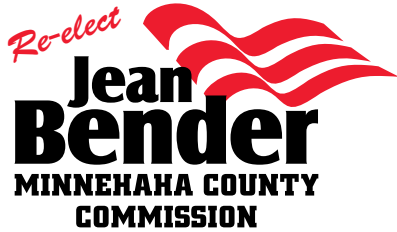

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
