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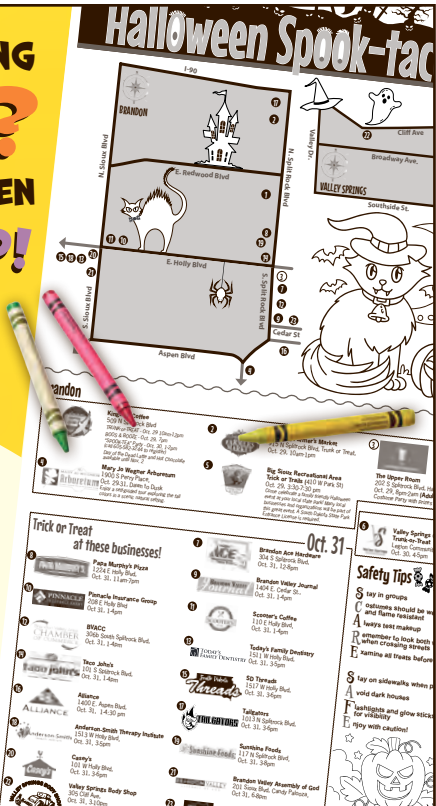

Automotive Advice from The Under the Hood® Show

Dear Motor Medics,

During my last oil change my shop told me I needed to change my cabin air filter. I did not know my car had a cabin air filter or even what one was until they showed me my dirty filter. They did not charge me much to replace it and my air seems to blow much stronger now. We had a Windstar van that gradually lost air flow from the vent too and I wonder if it had one that was clogged. My question is can they be changed at home by the average Joe and how often should they be changed?

Dear Mike,

Cabin air filters are appearing in more vehicles every year. They not only keep the dirt out of the inside of the vehicle, they keep the HVAC system components clean so they last longer. The filters are a great idea but until everyone knows if they have one and how to care for them, they can be a hindrance. If the filters are not changed you can lose airflow like you experienced and in the worst-case damage may occur to the system. When buying a vehicle ask if it is equipped with a cabin air filter and where it is located. Filters are available at most parts stores and can usually be changed at home in a short amount of time for a reasonable cost. Check the manual for filter replacement intervals.

Dear Motor Medics,

I have a question about those do it yourself air conditioning recharge kits you can find at many auto parts stores. I have lost some of the cooling capacity of my air conditioner and don't want to spend the money to have a shop check it out. Am I safe to just go buy one of those kits and recharge the system myself so I can get some cool air, and is there any risk of damage to my vehicle if I do it wrong?

Dear Dale,

Air conditioning is not hard to work on with the proper tools, training, and equipment. One of the most basic tools we use for testing is a set of gauges to read system pressures. We can tell a lot about the system just from the readings we take. If you attempt to charge a system without being able to read the system pressures on both low and high you run the risk of system damage. Just pumping in refrigerant is not the answer. Yes, there are people who use the kits and have had good luck but we see many vehicles that have been charged with a do it yourself kit come to our shop for repairs that could have been cheaper if done professionally in the first place. Do some heavy research and ask plenty of questions before you just add refrigerant using a do it yourself kit.

Cooking safety starts with YOU!

ALWAYS keep a close eye on what you're cooking. For foods with longer cook times, such as those that are simmering or baking, set a timer to help monitor them carefully.

CLEAR the cooking area of combustible items and keep anything that can burn, such as dish towels, oven mitts, food packaging, and paper towels.

TURN pot handles toward the back of the stove. Keep a lid nearby when cooking. If a small grease fire starts, slide the lid over the pan and turn off the burner.

CREATE a "kid and pet free zone" of at least three feet (one meter) around the cooking area and anywhere else hot food or drink is prepared or carried.

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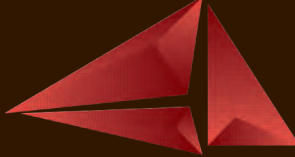


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
