The Brandon Community Library provides a place of reading, learning and fun for all ages - and it has since 1975. Merging with the Minnehaha County Libraries and the Sioux Falls Libraries, the Brandon Library became Siouxland Libraries in 1995. As the growth of Brandon continued, so did the use of the Brandon Library. Brandon Community Library joined with the high school library in 2003. The 10,000-square foot structure was connected to the southeast corner of the high school benefiting both the public and its students.

Minnehaha County residents, and nonresidents for a nominal fee, access the library's 27,000+ in-house books, magazines, movies, and downloadables; however, if the library doesn't own a specific item, it may be possible to obtain the materials through other Siouxland Libraries or interlibrary loan. In addition to offering collections, the library offers programs throughout the year for preschoolers, children, tweens/teens, and adults. If you're a visitor in need of computer/internet/Wi-Fi access, just ask for a guest pass; printing, copying, scanning and faxing is also available.

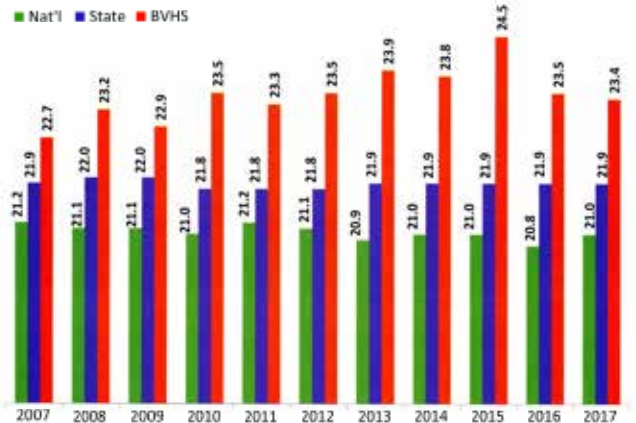

The Brandon Valley School District was established in 1962 to provide outstanding educational opportunities for this area. This consolidated the Brandon and Valley Springs school districts, along with 12 other common school districts, to create one large school district. The school district encompasses 128 square miles, from Sioux Falls residents on the west end to the Minnesota and Iowa borders on the east. It is an area that has been marked by unbelievable growth and economic development over the last two decades. This development has brought positive changes to the district in the areas of student populations and physical development. This one-time small, rural district has now grown into the fifth largest school district in the state of South Dakota.

The school district currently has four elementary schools, a new intermediate school, one middle school and one high school.

IN-TOWN BUSING

CITY PARKS

The **City of Brandon** has seven municipal parks, each with a variety of leisure activity options. The City also maintains a tennis court as well as a 146-acre, 18-hole golf course. For more information on any of the city parks or programs call (605) 582-6515.

Aspen Park is a 55.5-acre sports complex type park located in the south central part of town that contains eight softball fields, one baseball field and two permanent concession stands. It also offers two tennis courts, two sand volleyball courts, Radio Controlled (RC) dirt track and a large array of playground equipment. A bike path wanders thru the area and connects to Big Sioux Recreation Area. It is also the site for the City swimming pool that contains diving boards, slides, and wading area. Picnic shelters adjoin the area for picnicking and relaxation.

VanBuskirk Park is a 13-acre park that lies along the western border of the city. This park has a foot bridge, playground equipment and shelter with electricity and modern bathrooms were recently added to the park. Future plans show several miles of bike and walking trails throughout the park.



McHardy Park is a 74-acre park that lies on the southern boundary of the city. It boasts a large picnic area with shelters built along the beautiful banks of the Splitrock Creek. The park is equipped with playground equipment, modern restrooms, a volleyball court, a softball diamond, four regulation size soccer fields, concession stand, two-full size ice hockey rink (maintained by the Hockey Association) and a sledding hill for winter entertainment. A foot bridge crosses the creek, a 50-foot observation tower overlooks the park and a handicapped accessible fishing pier hosts a nice area for fishing.

McHardy Park contains several picnic shelters equipped with electricity that can be reserved by contacting: Brandon City Hall, 304 Main Ave., Brandon, SD 57005; phone: (605) 582-6515; fax: (605) 582-6831. There is not a cost to use or reserve these shelters.

Pioneer Park is a neighborhood park located in the northeast section of town. This park also borders the scenic Splitrock Creek and on the upper level is the home to playground equipment, a basketball court, full size soccer field, one practice field and 4 other small soccer fields, walking path, a sledding hill and modern restrooms. There is also a 9-hole par 3 disc golf course which includes a parking area located level to the river.

There is now a picnic shelter equipped with electricity that can be reserved by contacting: Brandon City Hall, 304 Main Ave., Brandon, SD 57005; phone: (605) 582-6515; fax: (605) 582-6831. There is not a cost to use or reserve these shelters.

Tallgrass Park This neighborhood park is located in the heart of the town and is the home to a playground area and modern bathrooms.

There is now a picnic shelter equipped with electricity that can be reserved by contacting: Brandon City Hall, 304 Main Ave., Brandon, SD 57005; phone: (605) 582-6515; fax: (605) 582-6831. There is not a cost to use or reserve these shelters.

The **Tennis Court Complex**, constructed in 2007, is located west of the Brandon Valley Middle School. The complex contains eight courts of which four are lighted.

Sunrise Park is another new addition to the City. This neighborhood park is located on Chestnut Blvd. and is home to a playground area and modern bathrooms.

There is now a picnic shelter equipped with electricity that can be reserved by contacting: Brandon City Hall, 304 Main Ave., Brandon, SD 57005; phone: (605) 582-6515; fax: (605) 582-6831. There is not a cost to use or reserve these shelters. Located north of the fire station, is **Stone Ridge Park**, which includes a playground. Seeding, finish grading and pouring of sidewalks and building of a shelter/restroom will continue through 2019. The City currently does not charge for any shelter reservations, but are looking in to changing that in the very near future.

Big Sioux Recreation Area-Brandon, SD

Lies on the banks of South Dakota's Big Sioux River. Big Sioux is popular among campers, canoers, history buffs and archers. For more information, call (605) 582-7243 or log on at <http://gfp.sd.gov/state-parks/directory/big-sioux/>

History

The Big Sioux area was home to bands of American Indians. The river provided fish, clams and waterfowl, as well as transportation to the north and south. Trees for fuel and lodges were readily available and drinking water was abundant. A log house and storm cellar marks the original Ole Bergerson homestead. In 1868, Bergerson helped Ole Iverson, the area's first settler, build a dugout. The men wintered in the dugout and the following year, Bergerson built his own log home using hand-sewn cottonwood logs. Some of the trees in the park are among the oldest in the state.

Trails

The park features over seven miles of trail, including opportunities for archery, biking, cross-country skiing, disc golf and hiking. Acres of native grasses and wildflowers blend into native woods that provide bird watching, nature study and solitude.

The GPS Adventure Trail was constructed at Big Sioux for those who wish to keep up with today's technology. Trail users use a Global Positioning System unit to find designated coordinate locations.

Canoeing

The Big Sioux River offers scenic vistas along its 390-mile course from northeast South Dakota to the Missouri River. This waterway, once used extensively by American Indians and fur traders, now offers an ideal setting for canoeing and kayaking.



Split Rock Creek

The river winds for nearly two miles through the heart of the park. Canoe launching facilities are available in the park. The free Big Sioux River Canoe/Kayak Map details the area from Sioux Falls to Fairview and is available at the Park.

Beaver Creek Nature Area-Valley Springs, SD

Developed to increase environmental awareness in visitors, Beaver Creek Nature Area highlights natural and historical resources in the vicinity. Pioneers named the creek for the numerous beaver they found along the winding spring-fed stream.

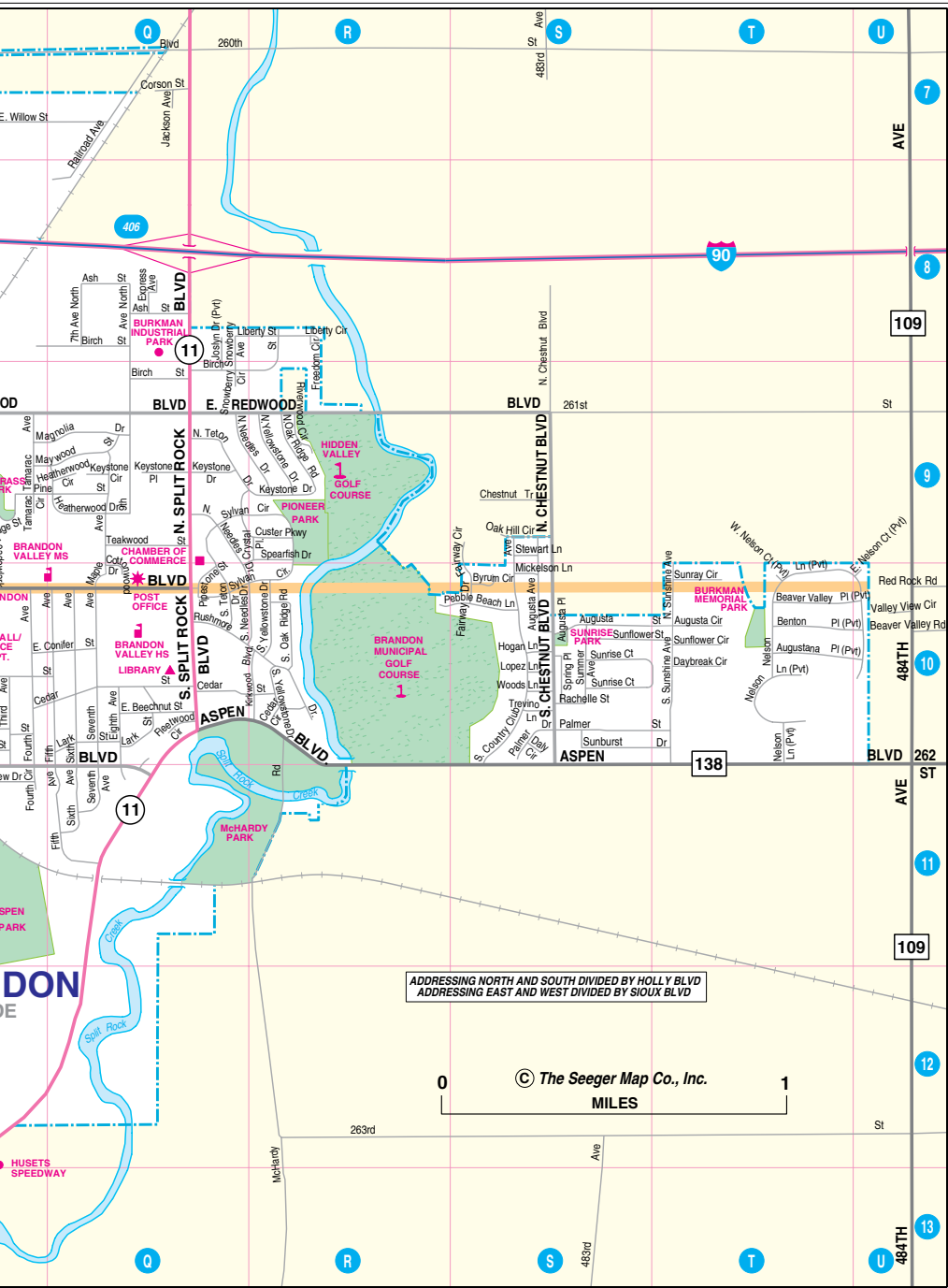

HISTORICAL SITES

American Indian Burial Mounds

Located ¼ mile past Badlands Motor Speedway on Hwy. 11

The Eminija Mounds were built by Native American people of the Late Woodland Period and may date from 500 to 1000 A.D. They are sharply defined and highly visible, though some have worn down from their original height. Eminija is an Indian term, which means “where the water splits the rocks,” hence, Split Rock.

Brandon Historical Society Museum

The Brandon Area Museum (run by the Brandon Historical Society) is dedicated to preserving, protecting and conveying the rich history of Brandon and the surrounding communities. Located at 109 N. Pipestone St., the Museum contains a variety of artifacts that serve to “tell the story” of our great community. Through the museum and the current renovations to the Nels Graff 1870 cabin, the Historical Society prides itself on serving the Brandon area.

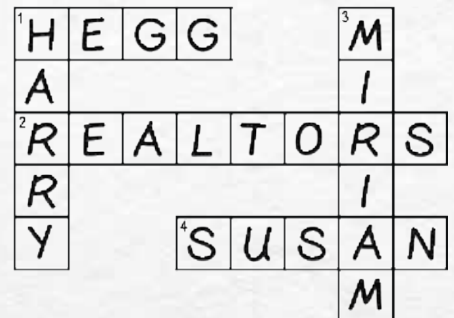
